Presidential Message

The board of examiners was successful in passing legislation this session that will allow the purchase of real property. This gives the board options moving forward and should help in long range financial budgeting. We would like to thank all the representatives that sponsored and help get the bill passed. Senators Arthur Orr, Gerald Allen, Greg Reed and Randy Price and Representatives Terri Collins and Randy Wood.

The board staff has been very busy this past year working on the upcoming transition with the retirement of our Executive Director Sheila Bolton. Mrs. Bolton was hired by the Board in 1995 as an Administrative Assistant and was promoted to Executive Secretary in April 1996. The position was changed to Executive Director in 2008. As Executive Director Mrs. Bolton has done an excellent job in overseeing all Board operations, routinely being recognized by the Sunset Committee for her outstanding diligence in keeping the Board compliant in all required areas. During her service to the Board she assisted in licensing over 1,100 doctors. She was originally scheduled to retire in October 2020 but due to COVID effects on the Board staff she delayed her retirement until May 1, 2022. This has allowed all board operations to continue as normal while we planned for her retirement. Mrs. Boltons' departure will be difficult due to the amount of knowledge she will take with her but she has been granted the ability to return in 30 days in a limited capacity by the State Personnel Board. This is a welcome reprieve that should ease the transition to our new Executive Director Mrs. Danyula Flowers. We also will maintain our Executive Assistant Mrs. Amy Deavers for approximately another year. Mrs. Deavers gives the Board 14 years experience to aid in the transition as well. While change is always hard the people Mrs. Bolton has hired and trained should make the process appear seamless to all of our licensees.

I would like to thank Sheila for all she has done for our profession and I would also like to personally thank her for all she has done in helping me as a Board member over the past 17 years. Sheila has always worked above and beyond the requirements of the job and even postponed her retirement due to the issues that were occurring at that time. She is the type of person that we all strive to hire as our office managers in our practices in that she seems to be able to do any task or use her ability to tap into resources to figure anything out. We will truly miss her at the board but hope that she will continue to assist us part time as long as she can. We all wish her well in retirement.
