The renewal process is much easier if you don't wait until September to obtain your hours and submit them to the Board. (18 hours are required for renewal each year with part of those in Alabama Law).

meeting was very interesting and allowed us to better understand todays Chiropractic education and what has changed in the past 30 years. I like the new format and I think it should allow for a much better testing of the clinician than the old format.

The Governor recently sent a series of Executive orders referencing the working of regulatory boards and agencies. The state is looking into possible consolidation of some board functions and possibly even going to a Board of operations model similar to Georgia. If any legislation is presented I urge you to reach out to your Representatives and Senators to object to the umbrella agency model. The burden I have personally experienced is a lack of continuity and no one specifically having any knowledge of a specific board since they represent many different disciplines. If this model is proposed we will let everyone know what to expect.

Dr Greg Millar is originally from Cullman Alabama. Growing up he was seen by Alabama chiropractic pioneer Dr. JL Below who greatly influenced him to become a chiropractor.

He was hurt in a construction lending accident and had back surgery. What got him out of pain was chiropractic! He decided to go to chiropractic school. He graduated with honors from Life University College of Chiropractic in 1997. While at Life University he was an SI in the outpatient clinic and was elected President of the Student Body. In post graduate studies, he completed his CCEP - Certified Chiropractic Extremities Practitioner designation.

He opened his first office in Decatur Alabama in 1999. He was asked by WAAY-TV, the ABC affiliate in Huntsville, to host the MEDLine TV show where he hosted 500 shows. He went on to host BackTalk TV show with over 300 episodes.

He now operates 3 regular chiropractic offices (Madison, Huntsville, and Jones Valley) and 2 specialty offices (Millar Functional Medicine and Neuropathy Laser Center).
