Presidential Message

I represented the Board of Examiners at the fall meeting of the Federation of Chiropractic Licensing Boards (FCLB). The National Board of Chiropractic Examiners (NBCE) and the Council on Chiropractic Education (CCE) presented the current state of our accreditation and Board examinations and the planned upcoming changes to our National Boards. The NBCE is working on modernizing part IV to be more case specific in testing the clinical decision making process of the student. The testing model is more in line with other health discipline testing formats. The NBCE is also looking to make possible changes to Parts I and II to test in a more clinical format and move on from retesting the basic sciences as they are currently formatted. The CCE is working on a model to create language that is universal regarding licensure that may be used in all fifty states. The model would be more in line with the current state of education and testing performed by other professions.

I was honored to present an award of recognition on behalf of the Board of Examiners to former Board member and past Board President Dr. Gary Randolph of Guin. Dr. Randolph retired after 60 years of practice and the community came together to honor him on his many years of service to their community. Dr.


